

ORDINANCE 20-2017

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$35,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF INTEGRATED SCBA THERMAL IMAGING CAMERAS

WHEREAS, the Madison Fire Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$35,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase Integrated SCBA Thermal Imaging Cameras for the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$35,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase Integrated SCBA Thermal Imaging Cameras for the Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$35,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase Integrated SCBA Thermal Imaging Cameras for the Fire Department.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
