

ORDINANCE 27-2021

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING
\$365,250.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
FUND FOR RENOVATION AND RESTORATION OF THE HARTLEY
DODGE MEMORIAL PLAZA**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to restore the Hartley Dodge Memorial Plaza; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has received a partial reimbursable grant from the Morris County Historic Preservation Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$365,250.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to restore the Hartley Dodge Memorial Plaza and other related work to offset reimbursable items; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of funds in an amount not to exceed \$365,250.00 for this purpose in the General Capital Improvement Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$365,250.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund to restore the Hartley Dodge Memorial Plaza and other related work. All work to be coordinated with the Borough Engineer.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
