

ORDINANCE 29-2022

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$555,000.00 FROM THE MUNICIPAL OPEN SPACE, RECREATION AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION TRUST FUND FOR THE DODGE FIELD HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBLE PLAYGROUND CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to construct a handicapped accessible playground at Dodge Field; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$555,000.00 from the Open Space, Recreation, and Historic Preservation Trust Fund towards the construction of a handicapped accessible playground at Dodge Field; and

WHEREAS, the Open Space Advisory Committee has unanimously recommended the full funding of this request; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of funds in an amount not to exceed \$555,000.00 for this purpose in the Open Space Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Morris County Community Development Block Grant Program has provided a \$125,000.00 reimbursable grant for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$555,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Open Space Trust Fund towards the cost of construction of a handicapped accessible playground at Dodge Field.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
