

ORDINANCE 36-2022

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING
\$100,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND
FOR ACCESS CONTROLS, CAMERAS AND OTHER SECURITY
ENHANCEMENTS AND IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Assistant Borough Administrator/CFO has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$100,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for access controls, cameras and other security enhancements and improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$100,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for access controls, cameras and other security enhancements and improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$100,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for access controls, cameras and other security enhancements and improvements.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
