## **ORDINANCE 15-2012**

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$50,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR EMERGENCY PURCHASE OF MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES FOR STORM SEWER REHABILITATION

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$50,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for emergency purchasing of materials, equipment and services to repair damage to the storm sewer adjoining the railroad at Station 1400+00; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 for this purpose; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$50,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for emergency purchasing of materials, equipment and services to repair damage to the storm sewer adjoining the railroad at Station 1400+00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$50,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for emergency purchasing of materials, equipment and services to repair damage to the storm sewer adjoining the railroad at Station 1400+00.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
