ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$8,000.00 FROM THE FUND BALANCE ACCOUNT CONTAINED IN THE GENERAL CAPITAL FUND TO PURCHASE DOOR FOR SALT SHED

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Superintendent of Public Works has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$8,000.00 from the Fund Balance Account contained in the General Capital Fund to purchase a new door for the salt shed; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the Fund Balance Account contained in the General Capital Fund in an amount not to exceed \$8,000.00 for this purpose; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$8,000.00 from the Fund Balance Account contained in the General Capital Fund to purchase a new door for the salt shed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$8.000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Fund Balance Account contained in the General Capital Fund to purchase a new door for the salt shed.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
