ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$10,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR EQUIPMENT INCLUDING RUBBER MATS FOR THE APPARATUS FLOOR, A FLOOR SCRUBBER, ADDITIONAL SHELVING AND VACUUMS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Fire Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$10,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for equipment including rubber mats for the apparatus floor, a floor scrubber, additional shelving and vacuums for the Fire Department; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$10,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for equipment including rubber mats for the apparatus floor, a floor scrubber, additional shelving and vacuums for the Fire Department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for equipment including rubber mats for the apparatus floor, a floor scrubber, additional shelving and vacuums for the Fire Department.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.
