ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$20,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR PURCHASE OF A STALKER MESSAGE BOARD

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Chief of Police has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$20,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase a stalker message board for the Police Department; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$20,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase a stalker message board for the Police Department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$20,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase a stalker message board for the Police Department.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
