NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals will be received by the Borough of Madison, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, in the Courtroom, Hartley Dodge Memorial Building, 50 Kings Road, Madison, New Jersey on **Friday, November 13, 2020 at 12:00PM** prevailing time, and at that time will be publicly opened and read for the **COMMUNITY SOLAR STUDY**.

This proposal is being sought pursuant to Local Public Contracts Law Competitive Contracting Rules and Regulations.

All proposals must be enclosed in a SEALED ENVELOPE, properly endorsed with the name of the Bidder, with the designation "**BOROUGH OF MADISON, SEALED PROPOSAL, RFP – COMMUNITY SOLAR STUDY, FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2020, 12:00PM**". **Any envelope that is received that is not properly marked causing it to be opened prior to the proposal opening will be invalidated.** Proposals may be received before the hour designated in the Borough Clerk's office, if they are mailed or hand delivered in person. The Borough of Madison will not be responsible for any proposal that is sent by mail or other form of carrier which is lost or which arrives after the bid date and time, Friday, November 13, 2020 at 12:00PM.

The Borough of Madison reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, or any part thereof, and to waive any informalities therein and to award the proposal in the best interest of the Borough.
