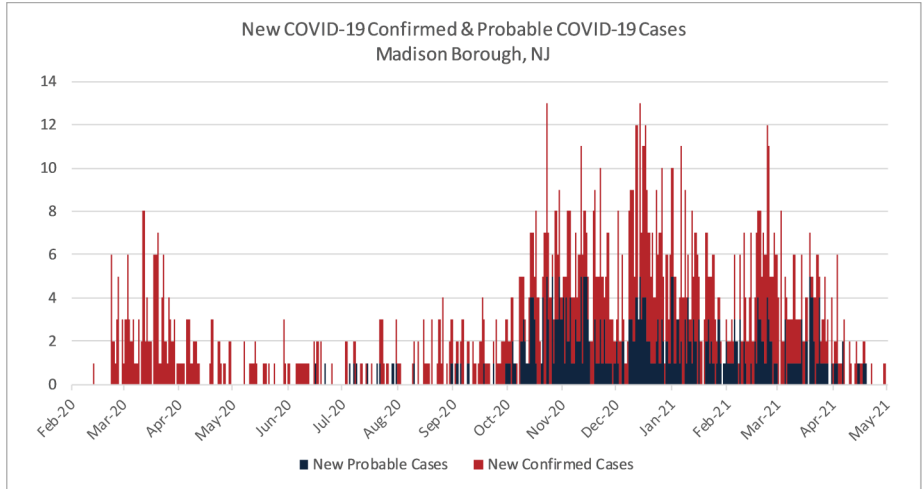

COVID-19 Update 5/26/21

Since the arrival of COVID-19 in early March 2020, there have been a total of 871 confirmed (PCR test) and 336 probable (antigen test) COVID-19 cases reported in Madison Borough*. The chart to the right shows the trend in reported cases over time. Fortunately, the number of new cases locally and statewide has recently decreased significantly and vaccination rates continue to increase. However, public health departments across the state will continue to closely monitor case activity and aggressively pursue contact tracing as statewide restrictions (masks, social distancing, travel advisories, etc.) have relaxed; case investigation and contact tracing efforts are even more important when COVID-19 activity is low.
