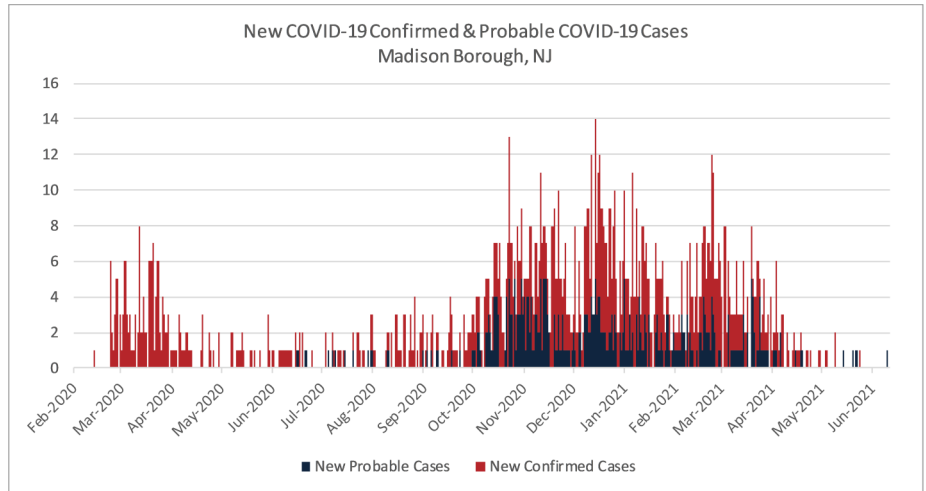




# Borough of Madison, New Jersey

## COVID-19 Update 6/30/21

Since the arrival of COVID-19 in early March 2020, there have been a total of 878 confirmed (PCR test) and 339 probable (antigen test) COVID-19 cases reported in Madison Borough\*. The chart to the right shows the trend in reported cases over time. Fortunately, the number of new cases locally and statewide has recently decreased and vaccination continues. However, public health departments across New Jersey continue to closely monitor emerging variants of concern, breakthrough cases among the fully-vaccinated, outbreaks associated with end-of-year and summer events, and new clusters in communities with low vaccination rates as well as aggressively pursue contact tracing to prevent further community spread and additional outbreaks where possible.
