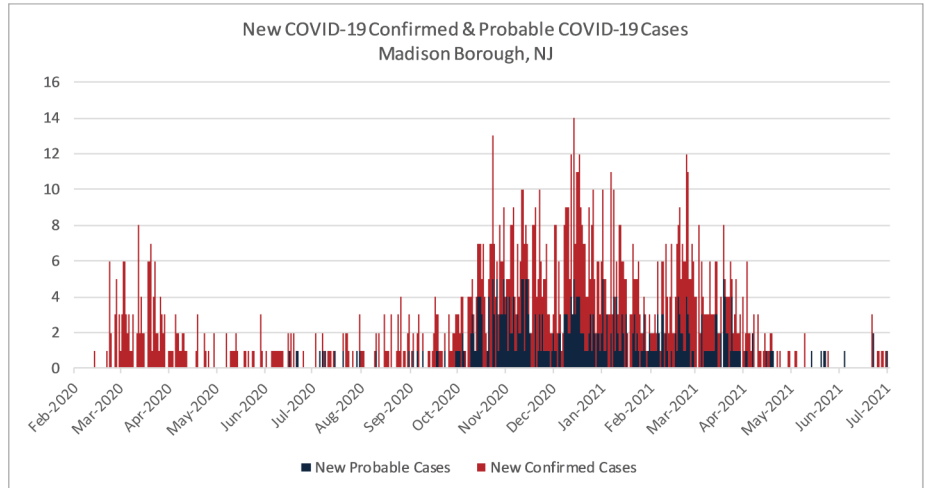




# Borough of Madison, New Jersey

## COVID-19 Update 7/21/21

Since the arrival of COVID-19 in early March 2020, there have been a total of 885 confirmed (PCR test) and 341 probable (antigen test) COVID-19 cases reported in Madison Borough\*. The chart to the right shows the trend in reported cases over time. The number of new cases has decreased and vaccination against COVID-19 continues. However, public health departments across New Jersey continue to closely monitor emerging variants of concern, breakthrough cases among the fully-vaccinated, outbreaks associated with end-of-year and summer events, and new clusters in communities with low vaccination rates as well as aggressively pursue contact tracing to prevent further community spread and additional outbreaks where possible.
